Addition To The Competitors Information Pack

There is an additional Time Card inside the pack of information you receive with the title 'Test 10 and 11 Route Checks'

Change to route instruction – Regularity A

The approach for the second grid reference should read **SSW not SSE**

Change to Route Instruction - Tests 10 & 11

At each **Stop Astride** marked on the test diagrams there will be a route check in the form of a number plate placed at 90 degrees to your direction of travel. In addition to stopping astride these route checks need to be recorded on the time card entitled 'Test 10 and 11 Route Checks'. Check 7, 8 and 9 are on test ten, check 10, 11 and 12 are on test eleven. You must then get the marshal at each of the test finish controls to sign against the relevant checks.

For Novices and Beginners Only

Change of hand out time of test and regularity route instructions on Saturday morning. For Historic classes N1 and N2 and for Targa Classes Novice and Beginner they will be able to collect their route information 60 minutes prior to their due time out at MC1.

In addition competitors in these classes will be given a sealed envelope containing marked maps showing the route through the regularity instructions in the event that they have problems with the route instructions. This is purely as a last resort for these competitors. At MC4 the envelope must be returned unopened with their final time card. Failure to do this will result in Exclusion from the event.
